At Balter, we're all about celebrating that enjoyment with you, because beer is more than just a drink: it draws tribes together and is a companion to many great moments in life. Our N.1 philosophy is that your taste buds come first. A neat can and cool place to hang are great, but if our brews don't tickle your tongue and put a grin on your head then we haven't done our job.

Balter Captain Sensible, Mid-Strength, Abv 3.5% 375ml 8
 This ale balances refined malt undertones against vivacious hop notes to round out a full taste and mouthfeel that defies its mid-strength nature.

Balter Pilsner, German Pilsner, Abv 4.9% 375ml 10
 The word 'crisp' gets thrown around when it comes to Pilsners, but that makes us think of lettuce. This Pils is more than crisp, it's straight up satisfying. The balanced malt base pulls you in for a hug before the hops get frisky with floral aromas and a refreshingly bitter finish. Perfect for those who like a 'beer beer', it's best enjoyed straight from the esky with the bar-b blazing.

Balter XPA, American Pale Ale, Abv 5% 375ml 10
 It might be pale but there's nothing weak about this bad boy. This XPA's tropical and floral aromatics set off a fruity palette that will punch your taste buds in the pleasure zone. Tailored for those who enjoy a fully-hopped beer that's still easy to drink.

Balter, Strong Pale Ale, Abv 5.9% 375ml 12
 Drinking this S.PA is like frolicking naked through a spring forest, then dive bombing off a mandarin-scented waterfall. We're not even kidding. Its clean hoppy base offers a relentless, yet refined bitterness complemented by pine and citrus aromatics. Here's cheers to a big refresher after a hard-won day

Winery in focus – I Clivi - Friuli Venezia Giulia

I Clivi are two separate vineyards, a few kilometers away from each other, vineyards that fall into two areas with different denomination of origin DOC (Denominazione di Origine Controllata) and also in two separate provinces: one in the Collio DOC, province of Gorizia, and one in the Colli Orientali del Friuli DOC, province of Udine, for a total of 12 hectares. These two vineyards are named by their toponyms, respectively Brazan and Galea. A minimum distance of few kilometers interspersed with a short plain brings macro sensory diversity that their decide to highlight through a separate vinification of the grapes coming from the two vineyards which is the determining factor in the differences of personality perceivable in the wines. I Clivi cultivated local varieties like Malvasia, Ribolla, Friulano, Verduzzo and Merlot. We are very excited to have this talented family as part of our wine list, hope you'll enjoy them as much as we do!

The most famous Italian wine regions are Piedmont, Tuscany & Veneto where Barolo, Barbaresco, Brunello & Amarone are grown. These wines have a complexity & earthiness that reflects the soil, the unique Italian grape varieties & Italian winemaker craft. Over sixty percent of the wine grown in Italy is red wine. The cool, mountainous northern region of Piedmont produces alluring, austere & complex wines, whereas the sunny, temperate central region of Tuscany yields bold, lusty, full-bodied sensations

Barolo

A well-made Barolo is one of the world's greatest red wines. Big, powerful and full-bodied with a complex mixture of tastes and textures - wild strawberry, tobacco, chocolate, and vanilla - Barolo gets better and better with age. Barolo is made in the Langhe hills region of Piedmont in the village of Barolo, entirely of Nebbiolo grapes.

Barbaresco is Barolo's near neighbour and stylistic soul mate. Barbaresco is also produced from Nebbiolo grapes in Barbaresco, Treiso & Neive villages, but tends to be softer and slightly more graceful. Barbaresco, too, requires aging - a minimum of two years and up to twenty years -to meet its full potential.

Amarone della Valpolicella

Amarone is made from air-dried, predominantly Corvina, grapes. Amarone is produced in the northern Veneto region near Venice, using the "recioto" method. This technique involves picking the "ears", or those grapes that protrude at the outside of a cluster and are most exposed to the sun. The result is a bold, full-bodied wine in a style more common to warm growing areas.

Brunello di Montalcino

Montalcino is Tuscany's second most famous wine zone, after Chianti. In terms of quality, however, it is the star. Montalcino is a small, medieval town just outside of the town of Siena. The wine district there is a warm, sunny, hilly area with few extremes in temperature, the ideal conditions for grapes to ripen to their fullest. The cool evenings ensure a high acidity. Brunello di Montalcino is created entirely from Sangiovese grapes. Brunello, "the nice, dark one" in local dialect, is Tuscany's most expensive, rarest, & longest-lived wine. By Italian wine law, Brunello must be aged longer than any other wine - a minimum of four years. Brunello is subtle with overtones of blackberry, black cherry, chocolate & sweet vanilla.

Valtellina Superiore Sassella

The Valtellina valley is locked in between the Alpi Retiche and Orobie, running parallel to the Alps, and it enjoys a unique microclimate. From dawn to sunset, the sun warms the terraced vineyard of Arpepe, which is set like a precious stone on the Rhaetian slope, fully exposed to the south and soothed by the cool breeze from the north.

The ARPEPE family are winegrowers for over 150 years and they have been passionately devoted to the cultivation of Chiavennasca (Nebbiolo from the Alps).

For 5 generations they have been using vats, large barrels, tanks made of steel or concrete and no end of patience: the ageing process will then be as long as it takes.
